This is a pairs event with players using alternate YELLOW and WHITE balls for odd and even number holes. Pairs have been randomly selected. Rules for the competition are as follows

- Each pair will be given a YELLOW ball at the start of the competition.
- One player will use the YELLOW ball on the odd number holes 1,3,5 etc
- His partner will use the YELLOW ball on the even number holes 2,4,6 etc
- DOUBLE Stableford points will be scored with the YELLOW ball, and NORMAL points with the WHITE ball
- If the YELLOW ball is lost, pairs will continue the round with WHITE
