SENIOR'S COMPETITIONS 2021

1. Notice of upcoming competitions will be published on the Seniors Whatsapp Group, by email and the website.
2. To enter a competition you will need to contact Des Rowe via the Seniors WhatsApp Group, email deshome@yahoo.com, or by text/phone on 07929 773410.
3. A Tee Time list will be emailed to all registered players and published on the website and Seniors WhatsApp group. The club noticeboard will also be used when available.
4. In order to keep social contacts to a minimum, and to avoid cash transactions whenever possible, a Kitty System is being used for all 2021 Senior Competition Entry Fees. The Entry Fee for each 2021 competition will be £3.50.
5. To play in Senior Competitions each member is requested to pay an initial £21 into the Senior's Kitty, which will be allocated to cover his next 6 entry fees, after which further top-ups of £21 will need to be made. (You are not required to play every competition).
6. Kitty/Entry Fees can be made by bank transfer to the account named "Horsehay Village Golf Club Seniors Section" (Sort Code 09-01-55 a/c No 95405185, inserting your name in the reference field).
7. You should also email Michael Shine at michael@shinedesigns.co.uk to confirm the bank transfer.
8. For those who are unable to do a bank transfer, Des Rowe will endeavour to collect cash at the club. However to reduce the administration involved, and to minimise handling cash, please make every effort to pay £21 into the Kitty using Bank Transfer.

9. Cards are available from reception or can be downloaded from our website. Members MUST include their COURSE HANDICAP on the card. Players should mark their opponents GROSS score for each hole in Column A and their own gross score in the marker's column. The shots received by each player will be 95% of the Course Handicap. There is no need to record Stableford points, though you can if you wish.

At the end of the round your completed SIGNED card should be deposited in the Box adjacent to the Emergency Exit door of the Clubhouse. All cards must be returned.

Scores will be uploaded to the results system by the Handicap Secretary – Brian Fuller, and will be available on HOWDIDIDO.

10. All bunkers will be in play, unless are given a sheet of bunkers that are designated GUR. No rakes will be available, so therefore you are allowed to place within 6 inches no nearer the hole. The ball must remain in the bunker.

11. The flag must remain in the hole and not touched. The ball is holed only if it remains in the cup

12. Prize money will be allocated in the normal way. The result will appear on Howdidido and you should receive the usual text.
