

Captain's Challenge

Format: A non-qualifying stableford competition with a maximum handicap of 24 for all players. All scores count towards the respective total team score.

Tees: Yellow

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members with a handicap of 28 or less

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player, 50% goes to Captain's nominated charity.

Prizes: The club trophy will be presented to the winner on the day & returned to cabinet. Club board entry for winning team.

Special Notes:

The entrants will be chosen by the Captain, President & secretary to play in one of the teams. It may be necessary to have reserves if the total number of entrants is not divisible by 3.

Captain's Trophy

Format: To be announced by Captain on the entry sheet

Tees: White

Entry Requirements: As decided by the Captain and included on the entry sheet.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: to be announced on the entry sheet. Fees to be donated to Captain's nominated charity.

Food: If required will be at a small extra cost.

Prizes: As decided by the Captain.

Club trophy & club board entry for the winner. The club trophies are presented to the winner on the day & returned to cabinet.

No vouchers.

Carpy Foursomes Pairs Knockout

Format: A pairs team, matchplay foursomes knockout competition. Each team will add their handicaps together then halve the total. This will be what the team must play off.

Example: Player 1 is 10 handicap & player 2 is 11 handicap. Gives 21 together, halved to 10.5, rounded up to 11. You would receive 11 shots.

1 team member will T-off from even number holes & the other from odd number holes. Then it's alternative shots till the ball has been holed.

Tee: White

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members with an active handicap of 28 or less.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player to be paid prior to draw.

Prizes: 1st prize only

Special Notes:

1. In the event of a halved match, the players will continue with sudden death continuing from the 1st tee. Handicap entitlements remain intact during sudden death play.
2. It is the responsibility of both players to arrange their match. If both players cannot agree to a match date the competition secretary will book a tee and advise both players of time/date. Whichever player is on the tee at the appointed time/date will be declared the winner. If neither player is present a bye will

be awarded to the next round opponent.

3. If a player is late but less than 5 minutes he will lose the 1st hole. More than 5 minutes he will be DQ'd. If both players are late the 1st hole is deemed to be halved and the match would start on the 2nd hole (Rule 6-3a/3).
4. A card must be kept for the match and signed by both players. It must be posted in the scorecard box.
5. Players must not practice on the course on the same day before playing the match.

Cosmo Giles Matchplay KO

Format: A match play knockout competition played off full handicap of the competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members with an active handicap.

Maximum handicap of 24. Players with a handicap of 24.5 and above play off 24.

Entry list: The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player to be paid prior to the draw being made. Payment to be made to any committee member & a receipt obtained.

Prizes: Club trophy & board entry to the winner. Replica trophies provided by Cosmo Giles to winner, runner up & losing semi-finalists. All presented at club presentation night.

Special Notes:

1. In the event of a halved match, the players will continue with sudden death continuing from the 1st tee, 8th then 9th if still square continue 1st, 8th & 9th. Handicap entitlement remains intact during sudden death play.
2. It is the responsibility of both players to arrange their match. If both players cannot agree a match date then Competition Secretary will book a tee and advise both players of time/date. Whichever player is on the tee at the appointed time will be declared the winner. If neither player is present a bye will be awarded to the next rounds opponent.
3. If a player is late but less than 5 minutes he will lose the 1st hole. More than 5 minutes he will be disqualified. If both players are late the 1st hole is

disqualified. If both players are late the 1st hole is deemed to be halved and the match would start on the 2nd hole (Rule 6-3a/3)

4. A card must be kept for the match and signed by both players. It must be posted in the scorecard box.

The Club Championship

Format: A 36 hole handicap qualifying stroke play competition. Full handicap. The competition is played over two days, 18 holes per day.

Comprises gross competition to determine club champion and net competition for 1st place in handicap division.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competitions off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player to be paid prior to draw.

Prizes: Lowest overall gross score (club champion). Club trophy & board entry. Club trophy for winner and prize/trophy for winners in all divisions given at presentation night. The club trophies are presented to the winner on the day & returned to cabinet. No vouchers.

Special Notes:

1. Players may be asked to tee off from both the 1st & the 10th tees on either day.
2. The second round will be played with the leaders of each division starting from the 1st tee (Division 2 the penultimate tee time and Division 1 the final group).
3. In the event of a tie of the lowest Gross, there will be a play off over the 1st, 8th & 9th holes. If still tied a sudden death play off over the same three holes.
4. Juniors will play for their own club

members will play for their own club

championship trophy rather than divisional trophies, although will be permitted to win the overall gross score prize. Away players will not be eligible to play.

Captain's Drive In

Format: To be decided by the Captain & announced on the entry sheet.

Entry Requirements: As decided by the captain and included on the entry sheet.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing date: The entry list will be closed 14 days before the start of the competition

Entry Fee: The entry fee is decided by the Captain and 50% will be donated to their nominated charity.

Food: If required will be at a small extra charge.

Prizes: As provided by the captain, no vouchers.

Gentleman's Invitation

Format: A 'better ball' Stableford off $\frac{3}{4}$ of full handicap. Each pair to consist of a HVGC member & his invited guest (can be a 5day senior member). Guests must have a valid up to date handicap from a recognised club & supply certificate. Handicap certificates from an established golf society may be allowed but must be approved by competition secretary before play on the day of competition.

Tees: White

Entry Requirements: Open to male members and their male partners with an active handicap of 28 or less. Please note, only one junior is permitted in a team.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: To be confirmed on entry sheet. 50% to club funds & 50% vouchers on the day.

Prizes: Club trophy and vouchers for 1st & 2nd. The club trophy will be presented on the day and returned to cabinet. Club trophy and board entry for the winner to be presented at club presentation evening.

Medal Winners Challenge Cup

Format: A handicap qualifying stroke play competition played in divisions off full handicap over 18 holes. Players will compete in the division in which they won their medal. Players who have won a medal in both divisions will play in the division in which they currently play.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all winners of the Monthly Medal in each division from April to October of the current season.

Entry List: A list of qualifiers will be posted on the notice board at least 2 weeks in advance. Each player must confirm his availability to play to the Competition Secretary or by initialling his name on the entry sheet.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player inclusive of £0.50p for the “2s” competition.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in all divisions consisting of prize/vouchers (value dependent upon entries). The “2s” money will be split between the achievers irrespective of division. If not won it will be added to main prize fund and a 4th place voucher awarded to each division.

Club trophy & board entry for winner of each division awarded on club presentation evening.

Medal

Format: A handicap qualifying stroke play competition played off the full handicap of competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 1 qualifying competition off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted on the notice board at the beginning of the month before the competition. The competition will alternate between the 1st Saturday & Sunday of each month, if possible.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition. New entrants will only be allowed to replace any withdrawals, at the discretion of the Competition Secretary.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player inclusive of £0.50p for the “2s” competition.

Prizes: Available to 1st, 2nd & 3rd consisting of prize/vouchers. Prize value is dependent upon number of entrants. The “2s” money will be split between the achievers irrespective of division, and if not won the “2s” will roll over. Medal winners will be awarded their medal the following month.

Medal (continued)

Special Notes:

The competition secretary will block book tee times. No group will be allowed to start before the first tee time published and no group will be allowed to start later than one hour after the last tee time published. A group shall start at the time and in the order that is on the start sheet, a group may start before its start time as long as it's still in the correct order.

Entrants are responsible for legibly writing their own name on

the entry sheet.

Midweek 9 Hole Stableford

Format: A handicap qualifying stableford competition to be played in 1 division, off the full handicap of competing players over 9 holes. To be played on Wednesdays, alternating each week between the Telford and Wrekin courses.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less.

Entry List: Entrants are responsible for booking their own tee times.

Closing date: The day of the competition.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player inclusive of £0.50p for the “2s” competition.

Prizes: available to 1st, 2nd & 3rd consisting of vouchers. Prize value is dependent upon number of entrants. The “2s” money will be split between the achievers, and if not “2s” will roll over.

Notes: Handicap allocation for each player is to be calculated using the 9 hole conversion chart provided for the purpose. The chart can be found in the midweek competition results folder and on the club website.

Mixed Doubles

Format: A non-qualifying pairs stableford competition played off full handicap of the competing players over 18 holes with both scores to count. Maximum handicap of 24 for men and 36 for ladies.

Tees: White and red.

Entry Requirements: Open to ladies and gents as a pair. Juniors are permitted if they have a handicap of 28 or less (male) or 36 (female). A maximum of only one junior is permitted per pair. Each pair must contain at least one HVGC member but a guest may be allowed as long as an active handicap certificate is produced at registration.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: To be confirmed on entry sheet.

Prizes: The club trophy will be presented on the day and returned to cabinet. Club trophy and board entry for the winner to be presented at club presentation evening.

Mike Morgan Eclectic Trophy

Format: The competition will run from 1st March to 31st October each year.

Each players eclectic score will be recorded automatically from scorecards submitted for all Medal and Stableford events played during this period. All competitions for which a Competition Green Card has been prepared and played over 18 or 36 holes (not 9 holes) are included.

The competition will be run in divisions.

The winners will be the players with the lowest total net recorded scores over the 18 holes in respective division.

Entry Fee: None

Prizes: Club trophies and prizes/vouchers to winners in each division to be presented at club presentation night.

Nigel Clarke 3 Club Challenge

Format: A non-qualifying stableford competition played off full handicap using a maximum of 3 clubs.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competitions off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player

Prizes: The club trophy will be presented on the day and returned to cabinet. Vouchers awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places (dependant on entries). Club trophy and board entry for the winner to be presented at club presentation evening.

Notes:

High & low handicappers will be separated with the low handicap players going out first. It may be necessary to use 1st & 10th tees to reduce overall time. Players may only use the same 3 clubs for the duration of the competition.

The Nigel Thomas Consolation Cup

Format: A handicap qualifying stroke play competition in one division played off full handicap over 18 holes. To be played on the same day as the Medal Winners Challenge Cup.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have **not** won a medal during the current season. Entrants must have an active handicap.

Entry List: A form will be posted to the notice board at least 4 weeks in advance, and the list will be taken down 14 days before the competition. A draw will be made and the list of tee times posted at least 7 days before the date of competition.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player.

Prizes: There will be a trophy for the winner to be presented at club presentation evening.

1st, 2nd & 3rd in all divisions consisting of prize/vouchers (value dependent of number of entrants). The “2s” money will be split between the achievers irrespective of division. If not won will be added to the main prize fund and a 4th place voucher added to each division.

Order of Merit

Format: Result of points awarded for all medal competitions throughout the season.

Entry Requirements: Automatic entry to all male members qualified to play in monthly medal competitions.

Format of competition: The net results of each medal competition will be taken without splitting into divisions and points would be allocated as follows:

10 points for all players on the highest score.

9 points for all players on the 2nd highest score.

8 points for all players on the 3rd highest score.

& so on down to 1 point

1 point will be awarded to all players who return a card.

0 points will be awarded for a disqualified card.

This could mean that all players would score points at each medal.

When the list of points is established, the player with the highest number of points from each division **after the last monthly medal of the season** would be the order of merit winner for each respective division.

Note: Any changes to a players handicap as a result of the last medal competition will not be taken into account.

President's Day

Format: To be announced on entry sheet

Tees: White

Entry Requirements: As decided by the President and included on the entry sheet.

Entry List: Posted to notice board at least 5 weeks prior to competition.

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: To be confirmed on entry sheet.

Food: If required will be at extra cost.

Prizes: Winner, runner up and 3rd place. The club trophy and president prizes will be presented on day and trophy returned to cabinet. Club trophy and board entry for the winner to be presented at club presentation evening.

Scratch Trophy

Format: A qualifying stroke play competition played off scratch handicap of competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing date: The entry list will close 9 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: To be announced on entry sheet.

Prizes: Club trophy & board entry for winner, prize/trophy for winner & runner up. All to be presented at Club presentation night.

Notes:

1. The competition secretary will block book the tee times. Special requests for later tee times must be made separately, speak directly to the competition secretary.
2. Entrants are responsible for legibly writing their own name on the entry sheet.
3. Play off 1st, 8th & 9th then sudden death.

Stableford

Format: A handicap qualifying stableford competition played off the full handicap of competing players over 18 holes.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members with an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competitions off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: Entrants are responsible for booking their own tee times. The competition will alternate between a Saturday & Sunday of each month if possible.

Closing Date: The day of the competition.

Entry Fee: £3.50 per player inclusive of £0.50p for the “2s” competition.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in all divisions consisting of prize/vouchers (value dependent upon entries). The “2s” money will be split between the achievers irrespective of division, if not won it will be added to main prize fund. Entrants are responsible for legibly writing their own name on the entry sheet in the Pro Shop.

Players are responsible for completing their own score cards.

Mike Morgan Summer Pairs League

Format: A pairs better-ball stableford competition, played off $\frac{3}{4}$ handicap. One round should be played within each month between October & March. All teams will be supplied with 6 cards marked one for each month. If a card is not completed within the calendar month this card will be void. Your best 4 cards will be used to calculate your final score.

It is not necessary to play against the other pairs in the competition, but a club member with a handicap must mark the card. Any pair that includes a junior player must have their cards marked by a gent.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competition off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player (£10 per team) to be paid prior to the close of entry date. Payment to be made to any committee member and a receipt obtained. The receipt number is to be written opposite your name on the entry sheet.

Prizes: Club trophy & board entry for winning pair and replica trophies presented at club presentation night.

Special Notes:

A card must be kept and signed by one of the member of the team and the marker. The scorecard must be posted in the scorecard box to be valid. The handicap of each player is as stated on the handicap list on the day of the round.

Each team will be issues with 6 scorecards before the commencement of the competition. These will be the only cards that will be accepted for scoring. If scores are tied at the close of the competition there will be a knockout round played between the tying teams

between the tying teams.

The Masters

Format: A 2 day handicap qualifying stroke play competition played off the full handicap of the competing players over 36 holes.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 24 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competitions off white tees since their handicap was allocated. Junior members must have achieved a handicap of 12 or less. Only the top 50% and equal of the entrants will go forward to the 2nd round.

Entry list: The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing Date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: To be announced on the entry sheet and paid on the 1st day of competition.

Prizes: Club trophy & board entry to the winner. Replica trophies to winner, runner up & 3rd place, all presented at club presentation evening. The club trophy will be presented to the winner on the day and returned to the cabinet. Vouchers to 1st, 2nd & 3rd consisting of 50% of entry fee. Remaining fees to club.

Special Notes:

1. In the 1st round, players will tee off in order of handicap with low handicaps going out first and the highest handicaps going out last.
2. The second round will be played with the leaders starting last of the competitors irrespective of their handicaps.
3. Both the 1st & 10th tees may be used.
4. In the event of a count back the 18 holes on day 2 will be used.

Clive Coton winter Pairs League

Format: A pairs better-ball stableford competition, played off $\frac{3}{4}$ handicap. One round should be played within each month between October & March. All teams will be supplied with 6 cards marked one for each month. If a card is not completed within the calendar month this card will be void. Your best 4 cards will be used to calculate your final score.

It is not necessary to play against the other pairs in the competition, but a club member with a handicap must mark the card. Any pair that includes a junior player must have their cards marked by a gent.

Tees: Yellow.

Entry Requirements: Open to all male members who have an active handicap of 28 or less and have played in at least 2 qualifying competition off white tees since their handicap was allocated.

Entry List: The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date

Closing date: The entry list will close 14 days before the start of the competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player (£10 per team) to be paid prior to the close of entry date. Payment to be made to any committee member and a receipt obtained. The receipt number is to be written opposite your name on the entry sheet.

Prizes: Club trophy & board entry for winning pair and replica trophies presented at club presentation night.

Special Notes:

A card must be kept and signed by one of the member of the team and the marker. The scorecard must be posted in the scorecard box to be valid. The handicap of each player is as stated on the handicap list on the day of the round.

Each team will be issues with 6 scorecards before the commencement of the competition. These will be the only cards that will be accepted for scoring. If scores are tied at the close of the competition there will be a knockout round played between the tying teams

between the tying teams.
