RULES FOR H.V.G.C. COMPETITIONS

- 1. All Competitions are to be played in accordance with the Royal & Ancient Rules of Golf.
- 2. All competitors must arrive on the tee 5 minutes before their allocated time times for the competition. Failure to be on time will result in a verbal warning
- 3. It is the responsibility of the competitor to advise the Competition Secretary of their inability to play in a competition An exception to, this rule, is family emergencies; however, the Competition Secretary should still be informed as soon as possible. Failure to do so will subject the player to the same disciplinary regulations as a competitor who fails to arrive for the competition.
- 4. Any competitor who fails to arrive for a competition will be subject to the following regulations:
 - 1st offence in any 12 month period: A verbal warning.
 - 2nd offence in any 12 month period: a final verbal warning
 - Any subsequent offence: Potential suspension from future competitions
- Entrants must be current playing members of HVGC unless otherwise specified on the rule card for the competition. Note previous year's membership will cease on 31st December each year.
- 6. Buggies could be allowed in competitions subject to approval by the club committee. See Buggy Policy for details. An exception to this rule is for the visiting team when playing in Friendly matches, provided the visiting team has given advance notice of the need for the use of buggies by specified members of their team.
- 7. The Committee expect, where possible, all competitors to remain for food and announcements following any competition where food has been provided.
- 8. No group will be allowed to start before the first tee time published and no group will be allowed to start later than the last published tee time, unless delayed by play resulting from an earlier tee time. For an early or late tee time within the allocated tee times a request should be made to the Competition Secretary stating the reason. The Competition Secretary's decision will be final.
- The Committee reserve the right to amend the rules of any competition at their discretion. Any changes to the published rules of a competition will be specified on the Entry Form and the Tee Times Notice
- 10. Additional rules for single and team Knockout competitions,
 - If both players / team cannot agree a match date, the Competition Secretary will book a tee and advise both players / teams of the time and date. If only one player / team is on the tee at the appointed time, he will be declared the winner, unless the other player / team arrives within 5 minutes of the appointed time. In these circumstances the player / team arriving late will be deemed to have lost the first hole and play will start on the 2nd hole (Rule R&A 6-3 applies). If neither player / team is present within 5 minutes of the appointed time, a bye will be awarded to the opponent in the next round.
 - One player / team may concede the match should they be unable to play within the designated timeframe. This will be at the discretion of the Competition Secretary
 - The competition round winner cannot be decided by any other means other than submitting a signed score card for the match or as described above. Disregarding this instruction will mean automatic disqualification from the competition for both players / teams.
- 11. Club members, are allowed to play practice rounds from the white tees providing permission is sought and given by the Golf Centre. Any such rounds must comply with the rules of golf.
 - The Committees reserve the right to amend the rules of any competition at their discretion. Any changes to the published rules of a competition will be specified on the Entry Form and the Tee

Captain's Drive In

Format:

To be decided by the Captain & announced on the entry sheet.

Entry Requirements:

As decided by the captain and included on the entry sheet.

Entry List:

The entry list will be posted on the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date.

Closing date:

The entry list will be closed 14 days before the start of the Competition. Tee times will be posted on the board and HVGC Website 10 days before the competition date.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee is decided by the Captain and 50% will be donated to their nominated charity or the Captains Fund. The remaining 50% will be paid out inprizes.

Mike Morgan Summer Pairs Knockout

Format:

A pair's teamMatch-Play Knockout competition. All players calculate their course handicap. The lowest handicap player will play off scratch, the other three players play off 90% of the handicap difference taken from the scratch player. Shots are then taken as per the stroke index of each hole. The competition will be played between 1st April and 30th September.

Tees: White.

Entry Requirements:

Open to all male members who have a handicap index and have played at least three Gents or Seniors qualifying Competitions off White Tees in the previous 12 months. New members will be allowed to enter if they have a full handicap record with 8 counting scores, of which 3 must be in competitions. All scores must be within the previous 24 months"

Entry List:

The entry list will be posted to the notice board at least 5 weeks prior to the competition date

Closing date:

The entry list will close 14 days before the competition starts

Entry Fee: £5.00 per player (£10 per team) to be paid prior to the close of entry date. Payment to be made to Competition Secretary and a receipt obtained. The receipt number is to be written opposite your name on the entry sheet. 20% of the entry fees will be retained by Gents section.

Special Notes:

If only one team is on the tee at the appointed time they will be declared the winner. A card must be kept for the match with the handicaps used by all players and signed by one member of each team. The scorecard must be posted into the scorecard box to be validated. The handicap of each player is as stated on the handicap list on the day of the round. If a card is not submitted the match is invalid and must be re-played.

Carpy Foursomes Pairs Knockout

Format:

A pair's team competition, match play foursome's knockout format. Each team will add their coursehandicaps together then halve the total. This will be the playing handicap for the team **Example: Player 1 is 10 handicap & player 2 is 11 handicap. Gives 21 together, halved to 10.5, rounded up to 11. You would receive 11 shots.**

One team member will Tee off from even number holes and the other from odd number holes. Then its alternative shots till the ball has been holed.

Entry List: A list of qualifying players will be posted on the notice board after the final medal. Each player must confirm his availability to play to the Competition Secretary or by initialling his name on the entry sheet.

Entry Fee:£4.00 per player inclusive of £0.50p for the "2s" competition. 20% retained by Gents section.

Prizes:Prizes will be dependent on the number of entries The "2s" money will be split between the achievers irrespective of division. If not won it will be added to main prize fund
